


Cyclo Workshop Tools have been designed specifically for the professional maintenance of bicycles. These tools should only be used by a competent mechanic, no liability will be accepted for damage caused to the tool or bicycle resulting from improper or misuse of the tool. Although these instructions have been written for best practice, manufacturer's recommendations should always be adhered to.

Read all of the instructions carefully and make sure all of the requirements are fully understood before proceeding.

Dual Disc Mount Facing Tool 07833



NB: This tool is for use on standard 51mm spaced caliper mounts, do not attempt to use on post mount systems.

1. Select the correct size Mounting Shaft for the drop out or fork either 100mm (A) or 135mm (B: 9mm or 10mm) and insert it through Bearing (C). Transfer washers and Bolts (D & E) to the Mounting Shaft in use if necessary.

2. Attach Facers (F) to the Body (G) turning anti-clockwise to secure, and apply cutting fluid.

**Note: Facers are supplied separately.

3. Offer the tool up to the drop out or fork end loosening the Bolts (E) if necessary, once in place lightly tighten the Bolts to hold in place.

4. Loosen the Disc (H) and align the Body (G) so that the Facers (F) are concentric to the caliper mounting holes.

5. Using the Crank Handle (I) where space allows or the Knob (J) where space is too tight, apply a light forward pressure and rotate clockwise with a steady even motion.

6. Stop periodically to clear swarf and repeat until a smooth even surface is achieved.
